Today, I would like to talk about the serious problems of food waste in Japan. By the end of

This is a typical case of "food waste"; food is thrown away even though it can be eaten. The
total amount of food waste in 2019 in Japan was over six million tons! That's about 50
kilograms per person in a year.

More than half the food waste comes from the food industry, such as factories, stores and
restaurants. The rest comes from individual homes.

The Japanese government has been trying to reduce food waste. But restaurant owners are
worried about losing customers if they don't serve as much food as before.
