【4】〔英文解釈〕No.22 [配点 10]

During the long and (1) history of the development of life on our planet, living organisms have adapted themselves with incredible flexibility to the conditions of existence offered to them and have reached that degree of marvelous complexity and admirable precision to be found in the evolved species and, in particular, in the higher vertebrates. Apart) being astonished by physico-chemical mechanisms that ensure the continuation of life in individuals and its perpetuation through successive generations, how can one fail to admire the perfection of those "sense organs" () allow a living being to know its environment and, 3 thanks to its mobility, to find there what can be useful to it and avoid as far as possible the dangers which may lie in wait for it? The marvelously precise structure and the extraordinary sensibility of organs, such as the eye and ear of the higher animals, stagger the imagination, and it seems incredible that (4) organs could have been produced by mere chance, even over enormous periods of time. The realizations of life seem to result 5 from a kind of organizing force which does not manifest () in inanimate matter and whose true nature is totally unknown to us.
